

## **ESPACOMP 2009 - Important information for delegates**

### **Getting there**

If you are arriving to Manchester airport, we have provided a coach which will depart for Bangor at 18:15 prompt on the 9<sup>th</sup> September. The coach (which will have an **ESPACOMP** poster) will be at the coach park, next to the train terminal (see map below). Follow the sign-posts to the railway station.



If you arrive at other times, you are advised to take a train or taxi. Timetables for trains serving Bangor are available from [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk). Tickets may be purchased in advance from this website or at the station on the day of travel. Expect to pay £80-£100 for a taxi.

If you arrive at Liverpool John Lennon airport, buses and taxis are available from the airport to Liverpool Lime Street train station, from where hourly departures connect to Bangor.

### **Arrival**

The coach will go directly to Bangor. The first drop-off point will be at the Ffriddoedd University halls of accommodation site. The second drop-off point will be at the Management Centre. You will be notified by e-mail prior to the conference, which place you will be staying. If you wish to transfer to other accommodation, you are advised to call for a taxi from either of the two drop-off points. Local taxi numbers: +44 (0)1248 353535 or +44(0)1248 370127

### **Directions by car**

To Bangor - The A55 is the best route. From junction 16 of the M56 follow the A5117, A550 and A494 with signs for North Wales and A55 Conwy.

Ffriddoedd site – from junction 9 of the A55 follow A487 Bangor. At the next roundabout by the suspension bridge follow A5 Bangor. Enter the 30mph zone and at

the roundabout turn right. Ignore the first turning on your right, the entrance to the site is over the brow of the hill on the right. If you are using a GPS the site postcode is LL57 2GP.

Main arts building (conference venue) – from junction 9 of the A55 follow A487 Bangor. At the next roundabout by the suspension bridge follow A5 Bangor. Enter the 30mph zone and turn left at the Belle Vue pub. The main arts building is on your right after ¼ mile. The Management Centre is a few yards further, on your left hand side. If you are using a GPS the postcode is LL57 2DG.

### **Car parking**

If you have indicated that you are travelling by car, we will provide a parking permit in your conference pack at registration. Parking permits are also available from the Ffriddoedd Site Reception, or Management Centre reception, upon your arrival. Any vehicle parked at Bangor University sites must display a valid Bangor University permit. This permit must be displayed clearly at all times. You may park at any University car park indicated on the map.

### **Evening meal (9<sup>th</sup> September)**

As delegates will be arriving at different times, we will not be providing dinner for the evening of the 9<sup>th</sup> September. However, there are a number of restaurants nearby, on Holyhead Road. Recommended places are the Greek Taverna (12-14, Holyhead Rd 01248 354991), and the Dragon Noodle Bar (10, Holyhead Rd 01248 372338). There are more restaurants in the city centre. There is also a supermarket nearby (Morrisons indicated on the map), and several take-aways.

### **Accommodation**

You will be notified by e-mail, prior to the conference, which place you will be staying. If you are staying at the Ffriddoedd University halls of accommodation, keys are available at the Security Lodge (marked as building number 30 on the accompanying map) or at Site Reception (if arriving before 17:00; Idwal building number 35), at the Ffriddoedd residential site. The Security Lodge is open 24 hours a day. All rooms must be vacated and keys must be returned to the Site Reception by 9.30am on the day of departure. See additional notes below.

If you are staying at the Management Centre (building number 60), check-in is at the main reception (open 24 hours a day). Rooms are available from 14:00 on the day of arrival. Please check-out on the morning of departure.

### **Breakfast**

If you are staying at the Ffriddoedd University halls of accommodation, breakfast will be available from 07:00 each morning at Bar Uno (see accompanying map, building number 33).

If you are staying at the Management Centre, breakfast will be served at the restaurant from 07:00.

### **Conference venue and registration desk**

The conference will take place at Pritchard Jones Hall (Main Arts Building number 51 on map). A desk at the entrance will be staffed by Sioned Smith, to whom all

housekeeping queries should be addressed. Conference pack and registration will be available from 08:00 on the mornings of the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> September. There will be a place for you to leave your luggage if required - please enquire at the desk.

### **Conference lunch**

Morning and afternoon tea & coffee, and lunch will be provided at Powis Hall, next to Pritchard Jones Hall (Building number 51 on map).

### **Presenters**

The conference Hall will be open from 07:00. Posters should be set up as early as possible on the 10<sup>th</sup> September, on the poster boards that will be at the rear of the hall. Adhesive Velcro pads will be made available. If you are giving an oral presentation, please e-mail your slides prior to the meeting, to: [cephi@bangor.ac.uk](mailto:cephi@bangor.ac.uk). Failing that, please take your Powerpoint slides on a USB flash drive to the technician before 08:30 on the 10<sup>th</sup> September, who will upload them for you.

### **Conference dinner (10<sup>th</sup> September)**

The conference dinner will be preceded by a drinks reception from 18:30 at Neuadd John Morris Jones (building number 72). Business casual attire. There will be regular shuttle buses departing from the Ffriddoedd Site Security Lodge (marked as building number 30 on the accompanying map) from 18:15 to 18:45; and returning from 22:00 onwards. The venue for the dinner is within walking distance (approximately 1km) from the Ffriddoedd site.

### **Departure**

If required (please indicate at the registration desk), a coach will be available to take you to Manchester airport. It will depart from the entrance of the Main Arts Building (number 51 on map) at 13:15 prompt on the 11<sup>th</sup> September. Alternatively, you may order a taxi to the train station, or make your own arrangements.

### **Additional information for Ffriddoedd University halls of accommodation**

- All rooms are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted outside but 5 metres from any adjacent buildings. Please note that all rooms are single bedrooms and double rooms are not available anywhere on the campus. Under no circumstances can beds be moved between rooms.
- Please be aware of other guests staying on the campus and keep noise to a minimum
- Bedrooms are available from 14:00 on your day of arrival. Check in is available at the Site Reception which is located on the Ffriddoedd residential site. It is open 24 hours a day. All rooms must be vacated and keys must be returned to the Site Reception by 09.30 on the day of departure.
- Please note there is a £15 non-refundable charge for lost keys.
- A launderette can be found at the Residential Site.
- Complimentary toiletries are provided with each stay. Your complimentary tea and coffee will be replenished daily.
- Rooms are cleaned and the refuse collected from the room daily.
- Clean towels are provided daily; however, in an effort to minimise our impact on the environment, should you wish to re-use your towel, we will collect used towels which are placed in the shower tray only.

- You will have access to basic kitchen facilities; however, please note that we do not provide kitchen utensils. Kitchens are cleaned and refuse collected daily.
- You can use your laptop in your bedroom to access the internet. You will need to collect a User ID and password from reception when collecting your key. Please note that the room at present has no wireless connection therefore you will need to provide your own network cable.

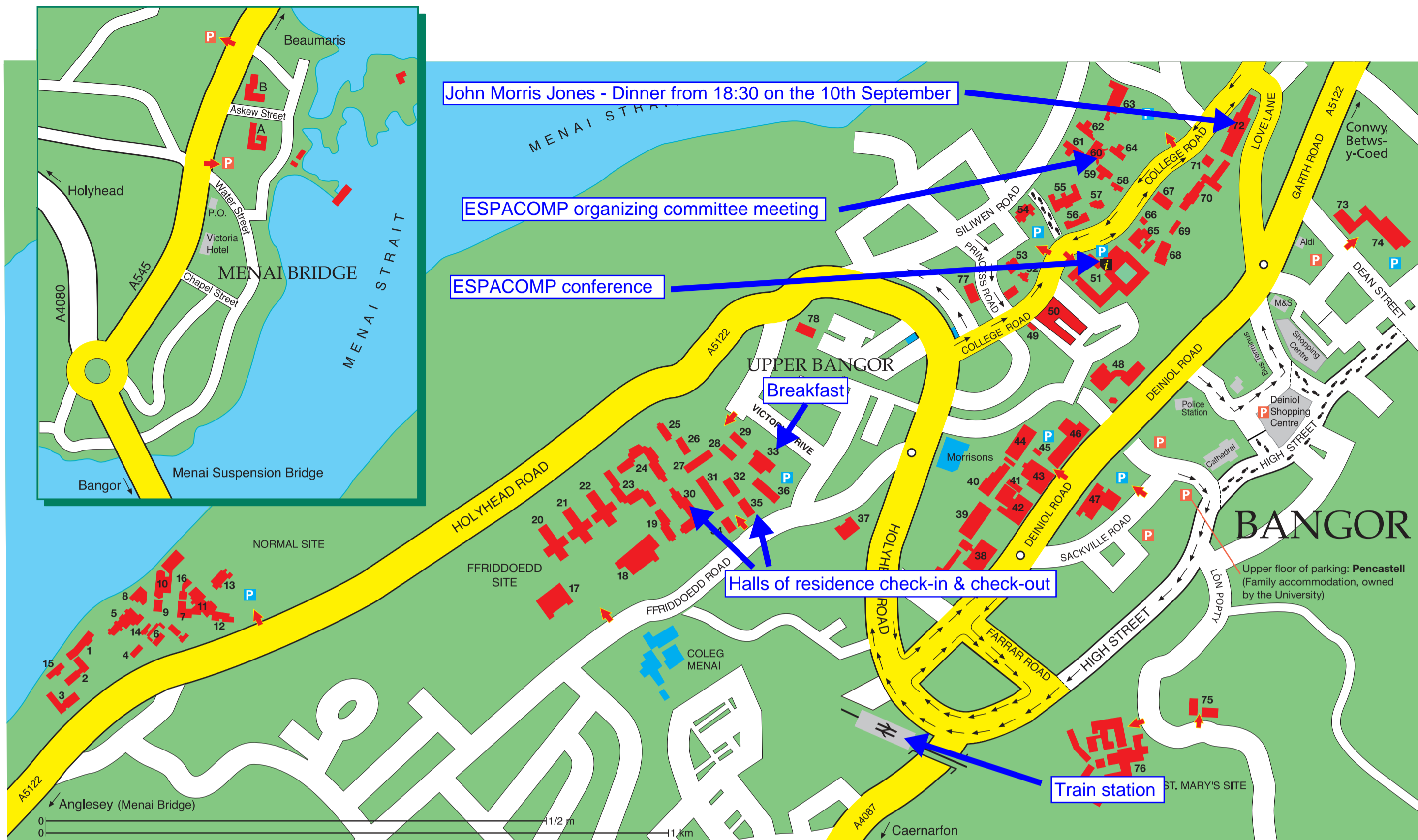
