PhD Studentship – Bangor University, Wales

Applications are invited for a PhD studentship in adherence research at the [Centre for Health Economics and Medicines Evaluation](#), Bangor University. This full-time, 3-year studentship provides full support for tuition fees (for UK/EU nationals), all associated research costs and a tax-free stipend of £13,726 in the first year, with annual increments thereafter.

This PhD will relate to aspects of medication adherence, including: defining core outcome measures for adherence, labeling instructions for missed doses, and an assessment of treatment response during periods of dose omissions.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants should hold a first class or upper-second-class degree in a relevant quantitative, clinical or biomedical discipline. A Masters qualification (e.g. in medical statistics) would be a distinct advantage.

The award is available to UK and other EU nationals only. Non-UK EU nationals must be resident in the UK for three years prior to the start of the studentship, otherwise they will be eligible for a fees-only award.
