

26th ESPACOMP conference – Berlin, Germany International Society for Medication Adherence NOVEMBER 17TH TO NOVEMBER 19TH, 2022

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Please read and respect the following guidelines when preparing your poster. As this year's conference will follow a hybrid format, we invite you to prepare **two formats**, one for **on-site** and one for **online**.

ON SITE

Poster Dimensions

The recommended printed poster dimensions are: **90 cm (width) x 120 cm (height)** (portrait orientation). Posters should be easily readable at about 2 m. The conference organizers will provide suitable fixing materials.

Poster Sessions

All posters will be available for review by conference attendees on Friday 18th and Saturday 19th, as described in the conference program materials. Poster authors / presenters are kindly asked to be present by their poster during breaks to answer any questions conference attendees may have and discuss their work, and thus benefit most of the opportunities of on-site meeting.

The formal poster session will be held on Friday the 18th from 13:00 until 14:00. On-site posters will be judged by a review committee for eligibility for the Jean-Michel Métry poster prize. Poster presenters will be asked to give an oral presentation of their poster (max. 4 minutes oral presentation followed by 2 minutes of discussion) to a poster review panel; the panel chairs will approach you at 12:55 to organize the poster walk of your content area. Please be present in front of your poster at this time.

The winner of the Jean-Michel Métry poster prize will be announced on Saturday the 19th at 13:30, before the ESPACOMP Business Meeting. The prize is a free registration to next year's ESPACOMP conference.

Mounting your Poster

The poster area will be open for mounting on Friday morning beginning at 8:00. All posters should be set up no later than 10:00 Friday, to be in place for the duration of the scientific meeting. Posters will be displayed on 2-sided poster boards; they will be hung on poster boards with the corresponding abstract number. The conference organizers will be present to help you to find your poster board. Posters will be organized by content area, therefore not by chronological or alphabetical order.

Removing your Poster

Please remove your poster on Saturday 19th by 16:00. The conference organizers cannot accept responsibility for any material left behind. The organizers are not responsible for any loss or damage to any posters that are not removed by the advised time. Posters left behind after this time will be discarded.

ONLINE

<u>All presenters</u> should upload a digital copy of their poster by **November 1**st at the submission site: https://espacomp.app.box.com/f/23a4db54e0bc4e3ba8de371b8b36f590.

The digital posters will be posted on the ESPACOMP website for viewing by registered conference participants as part of the hybrid conference. QR codes will be posted in the poster area at the Berlin conference for on-site attendees to view the online-only posters.

Poster presenters will be invited to be present **online on Friday the 18th from 13:00 until 14:00** (at the same time with the on-site poster walks) for an informal discussion with the other online attendees present. The session will be moderated and intended as an opportunity to network and exchange on the topics of the conference and the connections with their own work.
